

SILENT AUCTION RULES

1) Participation

- The auction is open to any person **aged 18 or over** with a **valid email address**.
- **No account creation** is required to place a bid.
- Bidding is **100% anonymous**. No personal data (name, email address, IP address) is collected.
- Participants identify themselves only by the **personal code** they create (see details in the form).

2) Bidding Process

- Bids must be submitted **exclusively through the designated online form**.
- **Each bid is final and binding**; once submitted, it cannot be withdrawn or modified.
- Participants may place **multiple bids** on the same item or on different items.
- The **minimum starting bid** for each item is set at €20.
- No real-time information about current bids will be available.
- A summary of the highest bids will be shared before closing: on Wednesday 18 March and Friday 20 March.

3) Closing

- The auction will close on **Monday 23 March 2026 at 23:59** sharp.
- Any bid submitted after this time will not be considered. The form's timestamp will serve as official proof of submission time.

4) Awarding of Items

- Each item will be awarded **to the highest bidder** at the time of closing.
- In the event of a tie, the earliest bid received (based on timestamp) will prevail.

5) Communication and Identification

- At the close of the auction, **the results** (item name and winning bidder code) **will be communicated by email**.
- **The winning bidder must contact the organizer within 2 working days of the results being sent.**
- If the winner does not come forward within this timeframe, the item will be offered to the next highest bidder under the same conditions.

6) Payment and Collection of Items

- Payment and collection details will be communicated to the winner by email.
- **Payment must be completed within 2 business days** of receiving the payment instructions.
- Items will only be released after full payment has been received.
- All items are non-exchangeable and non-refundable.

7) Liability

- The organizer reserves the right to cancel or modify the silent auction in the event of force majeure or exceptional circumstances.
