

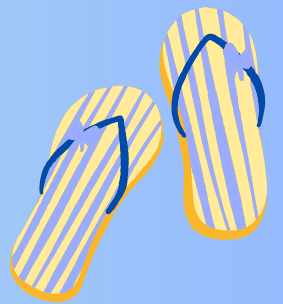

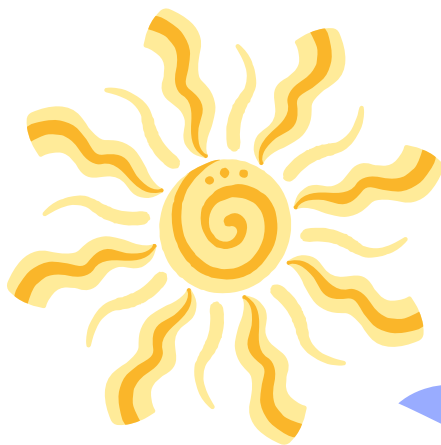
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Hooray, summer is back at the CPE!

Children from nursery school aged 4 to 6 years old

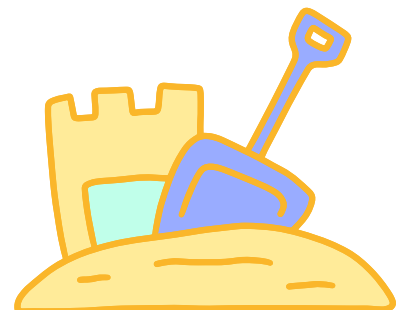
From July 6 to July 31

From August 3 to August 7

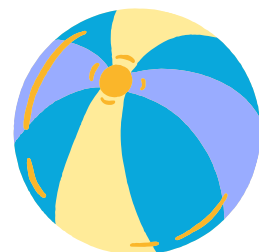

Primary and secondary school children aged 6 to 14

At the CPE, summer is all about freedom and following each child's own rhythm.

Every Monday, children choose the activities they enjoy most from a wide range of sports, creative, and fun options.

And if they prefer a quieter moment, they can also choose to relax and take a calm break.

Nothing is imposed: children are at the heart of every choice, for a summer that reflects who they are.



At the study Centre

From 6 to 10 July

Every Monday in July begins with integration games and a friendly barbecue.

The week then continues with a wide variety of à la carte activities: creative workshops, gardening, first-aid initiation, classic or more unusual sports activities... Thursday's outing to a park in Luxembourg will complete the programme with large outdoor games and activities.

From 13 to 17 July

Throughout the week, children will enjoy a variety of activities combining sports, artistic activities, and discovery experiences. Between mountain biking, painting workshops, cooking, face painting, computer workshops, and encounters with farm animals, everyone will be able to find activities suited to their interests.

A bus trip to a wildlife park will round off this exciting and activity-filled week.

From 20 to 24 July

During this week, children will enjoy a varied programme combining Lego building, sports, arts and crafts, theatre, and nature workshops. As every Thursday, an outing is planned: the children will discover the Caves of Han.

To end the week, group games will take place every Friday, along with a festive lunch break featuring a food truck.

At the study Centre

From 27 to 31 July

During the last week of July, children can enjoy the toy library or express their imagination through arts and crafts workshops.

Cooking workshops will delight young food lovers, while sports enthusiasts can take part in a wide range of activities (badminton, table tennis, curling, etc.). Other surprises, sometimes a little bouncy, will also brighten up the week ;-)

Children will also discover the Euro Space Center during a day dedicated to space and adventure.

From 3 to 14 August

From Monday 3 to Friday 14 August, activities will combine creativity and sports with creative workshops, mini-golf, and group games.

Every Thursday, an outdoor excursion is planned.

From 17 to 21 August

During this week dedicated to the theme of Robin Hood, children will dive into a world of adventure and discovery.

The programme includes archery, obstacle courses, craft workshops, and games inspired by medieval times to encourage teamwork and imagination. The week will also feature a trip to the Château de Bouillon, where children will discover the fascinating world of knights.

From 24 to 31 August

To end the summer on a high note, children will embark on a week dedicated to space. Off to the stars through fun activities exploring both the infinitely large... and the infinitely small. Games and great intergalactic battles will liven up this final summer week.

Young astronauts will also go on a mission to a Mars-like planet during an outing to the Parc des Terres Rouges.
